ALICANTE, MEDITERRANEAN ESSENCE

Alicante is pure Mediterranean. Located on the east coast of Spain is one of the country's largest cities, perfect to enjoy with all five senses. Open to all visitors and with an enviable climate, it boasts a host of sights waiting to be discovered.

Here you'll find some of the best beaches and bays honoured with the highest number of Blue Flags nationwide, along with a historical heritage left by the various civilisations that occupied this land, the highlight of which is the Santa Barbara Castle overlooking the entire city.

The city is full of stunning historic buildings, such as the Town Hall, the Central Market, the Casa Carbonell, the Cathedral of San Nicolás, the Basilica of Santa Maria, the Monastery of Santa Faz and the Hermitage of Santa Cruz.

It is also dotted with parks and gardens, the most famous and tourist-friendly of which must be the Paseo de la

Explanada, where locals and visitors alike stroll every day under the shade of its palm trees and on its attractive tiled paving.

Culture has a place in Alicante with numerous museums and cultural centres covering an array of themes. The Archaeological Museum (MARQ), awarded European Museum of the Year, the Contemporary Art Museum (MACA), the Gravina Museum of Fine Arts (MUBAG), the Alicante City Museum (MUSA), the Bonfire Museum (Museo de Hogueras), the Nativity Museum (Museo de Belenes), the Water Museum and Garrigos Well (Museo de Aguas y Pozos de Garrigos), or the newly-opened Volvo Ocean Race Museum, are prime examples of the importance of culture here.

Special mention should also be given to the small, quirky and stunning Tabarca Island, a magical place where the Mediterranean takes on all its seafaring essence and which features the first marine reserve ever created in Spain.









ELCHE, WORLD HERITAGE SITE

Visiting Elche means enjoying one of the few cities in the world that has three assets declared World Heritage by UNESCO: The Palm Grove, The Mystery Play and the Pusol School Museum.

All stem from the different cultures that over the centuries have passed through this Mediterranean settlement and the care with which the people of Elche have managed to keep alive such a generous legacy that survives in every corner of the city, giving it a unique cultural hallmark.

The Palm Grove, with over 200,000 palm trees, forms a one-off landscape in Europe and is a prime example of integrating nature conservation into a city.

The Mystery Play of Elche (Misteri d'Elx) received the UNESCO distinction as Oral and Intangible Heritage. This liturgical drama dates back to the thirteenth century

and has been enacted uninterruptedly since then thanks to the efforts of an entire city that has kept alive this cultural tradition.

The Pusol School Museum (Museo Escolar de Pusol) was born as an educational project and today has become a piece of history in the Elche countryside, with its traditions, crafts and customs being brought to our times for new citizens to discover their roots. Thanks to the effort expended over several generations, this museum was declared a World Heritage Site.

In addition to its rich heritage, Elche stands out as a modern and dynamic city with a major shoe industry famous across the world for its high quality footwear and design. A city of services, trade-oriented and always willing to show all its charm to visitors, who are welcomed as if they were in their hometown.











ALICANTE AND ELCHE, TWO CITIES MADE





Alicante and Elche are perfectly prepared to host the WVC 2016. The event will be staged in one of the most dynamic areas with the most favourable business and economic outlook on the Mediterranean Coast
